

INTERVIEW OUTFIT

Choose an outfit that shows the judges that you understand the meaning of "dressing for success." Again, you may already have something in your closet that would work perfectly for this competition. You will wear this outfit for BOTH the required Personal Introduction competition & the required Interview competition.

Be true to yourself and wear what you feel comfortable wearing.

The outfit itself is not being scored. However, your outfit should follow the "Attire Rules" listed under the Personal Introduction section of this guidebook.

PAGEANT PRODUCTION NUMBER SHIRT



Each contestant will be required to purchase the National American Miss T-Shirt for \$35 at the State Pageant or online before hand. You'll need to provide your own denim jeans. Princess, Jr. Pre-Teens, Pre-Teens will need to bring their own tennis shoes. Jr. Teens, Teens, Miss, & Elites will need to bring their own shoe of choice (such as heel, boot, tennis shoe - no flip flops). This outfit will be worn for Rehearsals, Opening Production Number during the Final Show, & Kick-Off.

oring the REQUIRED COMPETITION

Our experienced selection committee scores each contestant's ability to showcase:

Involvement in Community Service Project 10% Public Speaking During Personal Introduction 30% Poise and Presentation in Formal Wear 30% Personality During an Interview 30%

At National American Miss, emphasis is placed on a delegate's ability to communicate comfortably and confidently, verbally and non-verbally. While we allow age-appropriate makeup for our Senior Divisions (Jr. Teen, Teen, Miss, & Elite), we do not believe it should be worn by our Junior Division contestants (Princess, Jr. Pre-Teen, and Pre-Teen delegates). We do instruct our judges that, if they notice makeup on our Junior Division contestants, they may take that into account during their scoring.

ABOUT

You will be introduced, by the pageant emcee as you are escorted onto the stage in the formal dress of your choosing. (All age groups, except for Miss & Elite need an escort)

ATTIRE RULES

Princess, Jr. Pre-Teen, and Pre-Teen

- A dress that is appropriate for your age and shows your personality.
- Your dress may be any length and any style.
- No bare midriffs.
- Shoes should be small heels or flats that complement your dress.
- Noticeable makeup is not permitted.

Jr. Teen, Teen, Miss, and Elite

- A prom or formal dress that is appropriate for your age and shows your personality.
- Your dress may by any length and any style.
- Jewelry, if worn, should complement the outfit.
- Shoes should complement your dress.

There will be a rehearsal for this competition during the State Pageant for the contestant & her escort.

The walking pattern will be provided prior to the competition.

PRINCESS, JR. PRE-TEEN, and PRE-TEEN

SCORING

- Scoring is based on overall impression, and the contestant's ability to command attention with her poise and personality.
- Attire should be appropriate and contestant should be confident and comfortable on stage.

- Formal wear dress of your choice
- Complementing shoes and jewelry (if you choose)
- Emcee Card (found under pageant paperwork at namissinfo.com), will be submitted at Pageant Check-In and used later by our staff during this competition.

ALL ABOUT ESCORTS

- All age groups, except for Miss & Elite, will need an escort for this competition. Escorts may be any family member or friend.
- Escorts are only needed during this competition. During the Final Show, the contestant is presented on stage alone, and at that time, your escort would be part of the audience. So, your escort will need a ticket if they wish to attend the Final Show.
- Attire for Escorts: Something that complements the contestant's formal dress. T-shirts, jeans, and shorts would **NOT** be considered appropriate attire.



PERSONAL INTRODUCTION

REQUIRED OVERALL COMPETITION

ABOUT

Wearing a professional outfit of your choosing, you will sharpen your public speaking skills by introducing yourself into the microphone, on stage, & in front of an audience.

ATTIRE RULES

ALL AGE DIVISIONS

- You will wear this outfit for both the Personal Introduction & the Interview competitions.
- Pick an outfit you would wear to a professional job interview.
- No props, hats, gloves or purses.
- Age appropriate shoes that complement your outfit.
- Age-appropriate jewelry can be worn for all age groups.
- No noticeable makeup is allowed on the Princess, Jr. Pre-Teen and Pre-Teen age divisions.
- Age-appropriate makeup is allowed for Jr. Teen, Teen, Miss, & Elite.

COMPETITION RULES

Three things you must say:

- Name
- Hometown
- Something interesting about yourself

Time Limit:

• 30 seconds

Your Personal Introduction must be memorized. In addition to the three required things you must say, you can add whatever information you would like in your presentation. However, there is a TIME LIMIT OF 30 seconds of less!

If you only want to say the 3 required elements that is A-OK! If you add more, your presentation must be 30 second or less!

YOU BRING

- Personal Introduction/Interview outfit.
- Complementing shoes and complementing jewelry, if you choose.

FORMAT

- You will walk out onto the stage. The current state queen will then hand you the microphone, and you will introduce yourself to the judges and the audience.
- When you are finished with your introduction, you will hand the microphone back to the state queen & then exit the stage.
- There is no admission charge for audience members attending Personal Intoduction.

SCORING

- Scoring is based on ability to clearly, confidently and effectively deliver your message to the judges & audience.
- Following attire rules, as well as presentation rules will be a factor.
- Judges are looking for a representative who naturally conveys her unique personality through engaging public speaking skills & stage presence.

REQUIRED OVERALL COMPETITION

ABOUT

While wearing a professional outfit of your choosing, you will enhance communication and interview techniques. The questions asked will not have right or wrong answers. All the questions are about you, your goals, interests, & your personal experiences.

ATTIRE RULES

All Age Divisions

 You will wear the same outfit for BOTH the Personal Introduction Competition and the Interview Competition. See Personal Introduction competition for specifics.

FORMAT

- Your pageant resume is found on the Pageant Paperwork section of this website. You will complete your resume & turn in at pageant check-in. Our pageant staff will give it to you before you head into the interviews.
- You will meet with approximately 5 judges, individually. First, you will carry your resume into the room & walk to the first judge at table #1. You will sit down, hand your resume to the judge & they will ask you an open-ended question. You will interview with each judge for about 1 minute. Your interview with that judge ends when the bell rings.The judge will return your resume to you, & you will move to table #2 to repeat the process.
- After interviewing with the last judge, you will exit the room with your resume.
- This is a closed competition, which means no audience is allowed in the interview room.

SCORING

- Judges are looking to see if you can keep their attention with both verbal & non-verbal communication, so to appear as poised as possible -maintain eye contact & sit away from the back of the chair, with your back straight.
- You are interviewing for the job of state queen, so convey to the judges that you are ready for the job.
- This is the perfect time to talk about yourself. They are looking for a naturally enthusiastic & effective communicator.

YOU BRING

- Personal Introduction/Interview outfit
- Contestant Resume (located in your Pageant Paperwork), which you will submit at pageant check-in.

ABOUT

A full 10% of your overall pageant score will automatically be awarded to you when you do **one or more** of the following things, **prior to your State Pageant**, to serve your community.

- Donate a children's book(s) to your local/school library/an organization of your choice.
- Donate school supplies to your school or organization of your choice.
- Donate at least one hour to help others in need in your community.

Each year more than 20,000 children's books & items of school supplies are donated nationwide through the amazing NAM contestants involvement in the Community Service Project.

RULES

- Donations are to be made prior to the State Pageant.
- Only one item or one hour is required to receive full credit, but you are welcome to donate more!
- You are required to submit your completed Community Service Form, available for download from your State Pageant website, at Pageant Check-In.
- National American Miss will adhere to the honor system in regard to your donation.

SCORING

You will receive a full 10% of your required competition score automatically when you submit your Community Service form at Pageant Check-In.

YOU BRING

The Community Service Project Form (found under Pageant Paperwork of the state pageant resource website - namissinfo.com) will be submitted at Pageant Check-In and used as verification of your participation in this competition. **Remember, donations or volunteer hour are to be made/done prior to the State Pageant.**

WHAT YOU NEED TO KNOW ABOUT Sporgerships

The following explains all of the expenses required to participate in the competitions. Read below about what a sponsorship fee is, why you need one, and how to find your personal sponsor(s).

WHAT IS THE REQUIRED SPONSORSHIP FEE?

The sponsorship fee is the entry fee required to be in the pageant. Sponsors can be family members or businesses... ANYONE can sponsor a contestant!

All sponsorship fees are tax-deductible for businesses as an advertising expense, as they will receive recognition in our state pageant yearbook. Most family members, community businesses and organizations are thrilled to sponsor young ladies who are a positive reflection on their community!

All sponsorship fees are non-refundable.



WHY DO I NEED A SPONSORSHIP FEE?

Sponsorship fees help offset the cost of producing the pageant. Sponsorship fees pay pageant expenses, which include prizes, awards, trophies, judges' expenses, staff expenses, ballroom rental, staging, lighting, National pageant expenses, and the winner's trip to Nationals. Think of sports teams, professional athletes, and various community activities; these events are able to take place and these people are able to compete because they have the support of their sponsors.

THE BOTTOM LINE 3 REQUIRED COMPETITION FEES

- (1) Sponsorship Fee.....\$650 (2) Production Number T-Shirt.....\$35
- (3) Audience Ticket to the Final Show...........\$25/ea

THIS IS WHAT WE CALL "THE BOTTOM LINE." THERE ARE NO OTHER REQUIRED FEES!

ow do I get SPONSORSHIPS?

- Make a list of prospective sponsors. Anyone, any business, any person or organization can be a sponsor!
- Dress up! Look your best! It shows that you are motivated and prepared.
- Visit the sponsor in person! Phone calls, e-mails, and letters are not as effective as a personal visit. Try to visit your sponsor in person if possible. Even visiting over FaceTime or Zoom is a terrific option!
- Share the good news and your goal!
 - Tell the prospective sponsor the good news about being accepted as a contestant.
 - Let them know about the All-American family focus of the pageant.

Thank them with a note!

- Share your goals! For example: "To do my best to represent my community well, to make new friends, to gain life skills, and to have a great time with my family."
- Ask for their support. For example: "The fee to be in the pageant is a total of \$650. I'm asking ten people to contribute \$65 each. It's tax-deductible for businesses. Would you help me with your \$65 contribution today?"

What are the benefits of entering National American Miss?

This is an opportunity of a lifetime. In addition to trophies, prizes, scholarships, cash, and awards, you will gain self-confidence, communication skills, and valuable experience from interviewing and appearing on stage in front of an audience! You will make friendships that you will cherish for years to come and memories that will last a lifetime. In short, you will have a great time while building important real-life skills.

Is National American Miss a beauty pageant?

Definitely not! You are scored 30% on your Personal Introduction, 30% on Poise and Presentation in Formal Wear, 30% on Communication Skills and Personality in Interview, and 10% on Participating in our Community Service Project at your State Pageant.

Is previous pageant experience required?

Absolutely not! Anyone is quite capable of doing well and even winning in our system regardless of prior pageant experience. We will provide you with all the information and help you need. We are looking for enthusiastic young ladies who can proudly represent their state. First time participants make terrific Contestants and can make wonderful winners!

Do I have to get coaching or other formal training?

No! This guidebook, along with the training from our staff, will provide you with a solid foundation to create your own style and learn the stage techniques required for competition.

Do I have to stay at the pageant host hotel?

You are not required to stay at the pageant host hotel. However, the pageant does set up a special discounted block for the contestants and their families. It is often well worth taking advantage of the low rate and being right there in the heart of it all. Spend your time having fun and making new friends rather than commuting.

If I do not enter any Optional Contests, will it affect my chances of winning the overall pageant?

Absolutely not! Scores from the optional contests (talent, photogenic, etc.) have no effect on the outcome of the overall pageant. Optional contests are scored by a separate selection committee. Each optional contest is an opportunity for you to shine and be recognized in your area of interest.

What is a Sponsorship Fee?

The sponsorship fee pays for the cost of producing the pageant: awards, trophies, choreographers, emcees, lighting, sound, staging, selection committees' expenses, staff, florists, hotel ballroom rental, cash awards, printed materials, scholarships, office support, and all of the many other things that come together to make the pageant the best program for you and your family. The sponsorship fee is \$650 and can be divided up into separate payments.

You may have as many or as few sponsors as you wish contributing to make up your total sponsorship fee of \$650. Businesses, family, friends, or fundraising activities are all great ideas for earning your sponsorship fee. Sponsorship fees are non-refundable. Remember sponsorship contributions can cover any pag- eant related costs, such as Sponsorship Fee, Production Number T- Shirt, Final Show Tickets, Optional Contests, Hotel Room, Roses, and more. So don't stop at \$650!

Do I have to raise my sponsorship fee, or can we just pay it? It is up to you. You can either raise your sponsorship fee or pay it

yourself - or even a combination of the two - whichever works best for you and your family. Remember that the total sponsorship fee is \$650.

I would like to be in the pageant, but how do I get sponsors? The best place to begin is where your family does business.

Examples are cleaners, insurance companies, banks, doctors, dentists, local stores, etc. Call ahead to make an appointment, and dress up when you visit them. Visiting potential sponsors is good practice for your interview. Most sponsors will want to ask you questions about the pageant. They will receive recognition in your state yearbook.

Should I write my sponsor a thank you note?

Don't forget to write each of your sponsors a note of thanks! Be sure to thank them for making your dream of being in the pageant a reality!



Remember, sponsorship contributions can cover any pageant related costs, such as:

- Sponsorship Fees
- Production Number T-Shirt
- •Final Show Tickets
- Optional Contests

...so don't stop at \$650!

OPTIONAL CONTESTS

To take part in the National American Miss Pageant, there are the four required elements in which every contestant will participate–Formal Wear (30%), Personal Introduction (30%), Personal Interview (30%) and Community Service Project (10%). The State Representative is chosen from these four categories only.

National American Miss also offers a variety of OPTIONAL Contests; however, **you are in no way required to participate in any** of these optional contests & have no bearing on the outcome of who will win the State Title for your age division.

*Please note our events may contain fog and/or bright, strobing, and flashing lights.



TALENT

Got talent? Whether you sing, dance, tumble, twirl baton, play an instrument, etc. - this is your moment to shine. Take the stage and show us your live, solo talent in this exciting optional contest. It's your time to rock the stage!

- Available to all age divisions.
- The winner from each age division will awarded a Golden Ticket invitation to participate in the National competition in Orlando, FL, a trophy, as well as her entry fee to compete in this year's National Talent Optional Contest (\$175 value). The four runners-up will be awarded a Golden Ticket invitation to participate in the National competition in Orlando, FL.
- Talent performances must be a live solo performance.
- There is 2-minute time limit on all entries.
- You may enter this Optional Contest twice, doing 2 entries.
- \$150 entry fee per each Talent entry. (So, if you do 2 entries, it would be \$300)
